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## Who's eligible?

The Minnesota Department of Health has set the following criteria. Patients must:

- receive Medical Assistance, PMAP or both Medicare and Medicaid
- be diagnosed with serious and persistent mental illness, serious mental illness or serious emotional disturbances

- Behavioral health clinician
- Primary care provider
- Social worker
- Community health worker

- lack of support
- employment
- education
- physical or mental health needs
- substance use
