Health insurance policies

Your insurance is a contract between you and your insurance company. We will file your insurance claim as a courtesy to you. In order to properly bill your insurance company we require that you disclose all insurance information including primary and secondary insurance, as well as any change of insurance information. Failure to provide complete insurance information may result in patient responsibility for the entire bill. Although we may estimate what your insurance company may pay, it is the insurance company that makes the final decision. You are responsible to pay any balance left unpaid by your insurance company.

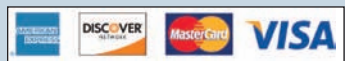
If your insurance company requires a referral and/or pre-authorization, you are responsible for obtaining it. Failure to obtain the referral and/or preauthorization may result in a lower or no payment from the insurance company, and the balance will be your responsibility.

Uninsured patients (self pay)

Balances are due at time of service. If other arrangements need to be made, please see a financial counselor. Patients will be offered financial counseling services in applying for Medicaid and Community Care programs. Financial counselors will also offer guidance to patients regarding state and local resources for which the patient may qualify, including Project Care Free Clinic.

Payment

Fairview Range accepts cash, check and all major credit cards.



What we expect you to pay

All balances are due at time of check-in. Emergency Department fees will be collected after medical screening has taken place.

Outstanding balances

Past due balances and elective service customers may be rescheduled upon the approval of their physician if payment arrangements are not made, including:

- Requested deposit not made
- Acceptable arrangements not on file
- Previous delinquency without good cause

Appointments: Patient/guarantor is expected to resolve their identified financial obligations prior to their scheduled date and time of service. If the patient does not resolve their balance, their service(s) may be reviewed for rescheduling or cancellation.

Emergency patients: Fairview Range will provide emergency and labor services regardless of the patient's ability to pay for those services, consistent with our organizational mission and compliance with the applicable Federal and State regulations. Emergency cases completing treatment and having been stabilized will be requested, prior to discharge, to resolve their identified financial obligations.

Labor and delivery

Fairview Range will estimate your financial obligations based on a normal delivery, without complications to mom and baby. Deductible and/or coinsurances will be collected prior to your delivery.

Deposits

Requested deposits may be applicable for services after insurance and financial screening of pre-scheduled patients.

Emergency Room services (treated and released)	\$200 per visit
Clinic visit.....	\$50 per visit
Estimated deductible/coinsurance	50%

Community care

Fairview Range will do everything possible to provide the maximum amount of charitable services to those persons unable to pay for services due to lack of financial resources. Patients who have health insurance may qualify for assistance on their remaining balance (co-insurance/deductibles) after insurance pays.
